**RE: Covid-19 Update – Auckland at Alert Level 2**

I am pleased to advise you that following the Prime Minister's announcement this evening, we are in a position to welcome back all students and staff on Monday morning, 8 March.

- **School re-opening Monday 8 March**

- Buses will operate as per normal. Face coverings are optional for school contracted buses, but compulsory for all public buses.
- Some in-school co-curricular activities involving large gatherings will be postponed until we return to alert level 1.
- The school cafeteria will be open.
- Students are encouraged to bring their own water bottles.

- **Public health advice**

- Fundamental health measures will continue to be in place as per previous lockdowns
- If feeling unwell, please stay home and consult a doctor
- Hand hygiene and sanitising will be encouraged
- Coughing and sneezing etiquette is a must
- The school will continue to disinfect touch surfaces

- **Weekend Sport**

- College Sport Auckland has advised that all College Sport competitions can resume limited to no more than 100 people.

As this week ends, I remind all our community of the duty we have to follow the advice of the health professionals so we can avoid further lockdowns and collectively stay safe and well.
