### **IN-ZONE ENROLMENTS - NEW CLOSING DATE** **Wednesday 2 September, 3:00pm**

We would like to remind all parents and caregivers that due to Auckland moving to Alert Level 3, the new closing date for in-zone applications is **Wednesday 2 September**.

Due to the effects of Covid-19, there will be no enrolment meetings this year however, all applications must be submitted in person to the Howick College Reception Office.

Applications cannot be processed without your proof of address and proof of identity as detailed on our [website](#) and all completed enrolment forms.

Please note that we can only accept a recent and complete electricity invoice that **clearly shows the supply address**.

### **OUT OF ZONE ENROLMENTS - CLOSING DATE** **Wednesday 2 September, 3:00pm**

Out of zone families must submit ALL completed Enrolment Forms along with Proof of Identity and Guardianship to Howick College's Reception Office **before 3:00pm on Wednesday 2 September** in order to go into the ballot.

**No Out-of-Zone applications will be accepted after the closing date.**

The Out of Zone Ballot will be drawn on Wednesday 9 September and all families will be notified whether they have been successful. Successful families will then have 14 days to confirm their acceptance of place.

#### TARGETED TRAINING & APPRENTICESHIP FUND TTAF (Free Trades Training)

The TTAF will cover fees from **1 July 2020 until 31 December 2022** and is paid directly to tertiary education organisations. The TTAF will make a range of training and apprenticeship programmes, below degree level, free for learners.

##### The TTAF will cover study in the following areas:

- All apprenticeships
- Level 3-7 sub-degree programmes in targeted areas delivered by tertiary providers
- Industry training, outside of apprenticeships, in targeted areas.

##### The targeted areas are:

- Primary industries, including agriculture, horticulture and viticulture, fisheries and forestry;
- Construction, including building, plumbing, and civil engineering;
- Community support, including youth work, care for elderly, counselling, and community health including mental health and addiction support
- Manufacturing and mechanical engineering and technology;
- Electrical engineering; and

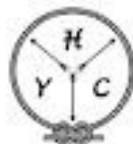
